**PROFILE**



A person who harasses or persecutes someone with unwanted and obsessive attention.

**PRIVACY**



Currently circulating story or report of uncertain or doubtful truth.

**CYBERGROOMING**



Description of individuals' social characteristics that identify them on social media sites such as Instagram and Facebook

**RUMOURS**



Someone (often an adult) befriends a child online and builds an emotional connection with future intentions of sexual abuse

**STALKER**



Level of protection an individual has while connected to the Internet.

**TROLL**



People who use negative and critical comments and behavior to bring another person down

**HATERS**



News stories that are false: the story itself is fabricated, with no verifiable facts, sources or quotes

**FAKE NEWS**



People who deliberately provoke others online

**GOSSIP**



User who follows your account and is able to see, like, and comment on any media you post to your profile

**FOLLOWERS**



Account in which no one can see your photos or stories unless you approve them.

**PRIVATE ACCOUNT**



Person who talks or creates rumours involving the personal lives of other people
