## Common Expressions in English

Expression	Meaning	Example
What's up?	Hello / How are you?	"Hey, what's up?"
No way!	I can't believe it!	"You met Beyoncé? No way!"
Hang on.	Wait a moment.	"Hang on, I'm coming."
That's cool.	That's nice.	"Your new shoes? That's cool!"
I'm just kidding.	I'm joking.	"Relax, I'm just kidding!"

I don't get it.	I don't understand.	"This homework? I don't get it."
Chill out!	Relax!	"You're too angry – chill out!"
You bet!	Definitely!	"Can I count on you?" "You bet!"
Piece of cake	Very easy	"That test was a piece of cake."
I'm broke.	I have no money.	"I can't go out – I'm broke."

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## Warm-up Game: Expression Charades

- One student acts out an expression (e.g., "I'm broke"), others guess it.
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## Speaking Practice

**Activity:** *"Talk like a native!"*

In pairs or groups, students practice mini-dialogues using 3-5 expressions:

 Example:

A: "Hey, what's up?"

B: "Not much! Wanna hang out?"

A: "I'm broke."

B: "No way!"

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## Listening Practice
