Multiplicación de Fracciones

1. Para multiplicar fracciones se multiplican numeradores y denominadores entre sí.

Ejemplo:

$$\text{a) } \frac{2}{5} \times \frac{3}{7} = \frac{6}{35} \quad \text{b) } 8 \times \frac{3}{5} = \frac{8}{1} \times \frac{3}{5} = \frac{24}{5}$$
