



We use **there is** to talk about one thing or person.
We usually use the short form, **there's**.

There's a table. **There's** a bed.

We use **there are** to talk about two or more things or people.

There are three dolls. **There are** eleven pencils.

We use the prepositions **in**, **on** and **under** to say where something is.



It's **in** the cupboard.



It's **on** the table.



It's **under** the bed.

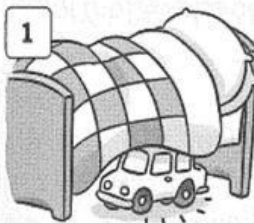

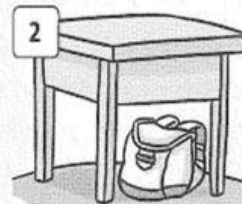

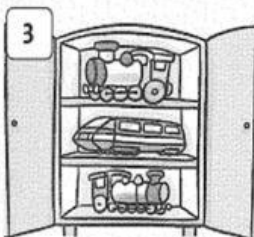
