



History of the compass

The first compass was used in Ancient China over two thousand years ago.

The first compasses had a very thin piece of metal called a needle. This was put on a piece of wood that was floated on a dish of water. These were mainly used when the sun or stars weren't seen in the sky.

Later compasses showed four directions, but over time their design was changed to show 32 points or directions.

By the 1700s, compasses were often used by sailing ships to help people know where to travel.

Today, there are many different types of compasses. The solar compass is used to help people find their way by using the sun. It uses the shadows from the sun. Solar compasses are made by putting a stick in the ground. Stones are placed around it and string is used to follow the shadow. This helps you find the direction you want to go.
