Forty-nine years at sea

In 2012, a man called Norman Stanton found a glass jar on a beach in New Jersey, USA. Inside, there was a message with the date 16 August 1963. The message said that it was a scientific experiment by Dennis Komsa, aged 12, from Paterson, New Jersey. The message included some questions; for example, 'Where, when and how did you find the jar?' Mr Komsa was 61 years old when Mr Stanton contacted him. He was very surprised! It was also interesting that after almost 50 years, Mr Stanton found the jar only about 400 metres away from the place where Dennis threw it into the ocean.

An unexpected friend

In 2014, Dwayne Bowen was riding his motorbike on a beach in Queensland, Australia, when he found a bottle. Inside, there was a piece of paper. It was a letter written in French from a six-year-old girl called Camille from French Polynesia, 7,000 kilometres away. She was looking for a friend to write letters to. After the story was in the news, the girl's family contacted Dwayne and his family. Camille was nine years old and she was living on the island of Réunion in the Indian Ocean.
