 Does
 Is work
 works



She **doesn't learn** English at the moment.
 don't learn
 isn't learning



What time **do** they **getting up**?
 does
 are gets up
 get up



I **doesn't take** the dog for a walk every day.
 don't take
 am not taking



Where **are** they **living**? In a house or a flat?
 does
 do lives
 live



Bill **doesn't running** now.
 isn't run
