

B. Prediction:


Look at the title “How do I get there?” What do you think the story will be about?

Nat I'm outside the chemist's. It's on the right, opposite a small park.  
Sam Thanks, I'm coming straightaway. Bye.  
Phil He's very lucky we found it.  
Julie Not lucky, silly. Only silly people lose their mobiles.  
Nat Well, I'm late now. Can I use your mobile to call my mum, Julie?  
Julie Yeah! Um... er... Where's my mobile?
