We use **ordinal numbers** for dates.

1st – first

2nd – second

3rd – third

4th – fourth

5th – fifth

6th – sixth

7th – seventh

8th – eighth

9th – ninth

10th – tenth

11th – eleventh

12th – twelfth

13th – thirteenth

14th – fourteenth

15th – fifteenth

16th – sixteenth

17th – seventeenth

18th – eighteenth

19th – nineteenth

20th – twentieth

21st – twenty-first

22nd – twenty-second

23rd – twenty-third

24th – twenty-fourth

25th – twenty-fifth

26th – twenty-sixth

27th – twenty-seventh

28th – twenty-eighth

29th – twenty-ninth

30th – thirtieth

31st – thirty-first

Likes & Dislikes with Verb + -ing

We use these verbs to talk about our feelings:

- **love + verb-ing** → very strong positive (I love dancing).
- **like + verb-ing** → positive (I like reading).
- **don't mind + verb-ing** → neutral, it's OK (I don't mind cooking).
- **don't like + verb-ing** → negative (I don't like running).
- **hate + verb-ing** → very strong negative (I hate waiting).

Subject pronouns	Object pronouns
I	me
you	you
he	him
she	her
it	it
we	us
they	them

- *We know them. They know us.*
