👉 If the adjective is short (1 syllable), use -er than.

- cold → colder than
- big → bigger than

👉 If the adjective is long (2 or more syllables), use more ... than.

- freezing → more freezing than
- beautiful → more beautiful than
- dangerous → more dangerous than

Mercury is ____ than Venus. (cold)

Earth is ____ than Mars. (big)

Jupiter is ____ than Earth. (cold)

Uranus is ____ than Neptune. (beautiful)

The weather on Venus is ____ than the weather on Earth.
(dangerous)

Saturn is ____ than Mercury. (colourful)

Neptune is _____ than Saturn. (freezing)



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👉 If the adjective ends in -e, drop the e and add -er.

- large → larger than
- nice → nicer than

👉 If the adjective ends with consonant + vowel + consonant (CVC), double the last consonant.

- hot → hotter than
- big → bigger than

👉 If the adjective ends in consonant + y, change y → i and add -er.

- happy → happier than
