However, if their wives or girlfriends are passengers, they drive more carefully. On the other hand, female drivers become less safe when their husbands or boyfriends are in the car, possibly due to distractions or pressure.

Both men and women tend to drive more safely when their children are with them. This suggests that passengers can have a strong effect on a driver's behavior, making them either more cautious or more reckless.
