GLOBAL WARNING AND OUR FUTURE

Global warming has been changing the planet in serious ways. Scientists say that if the Earth's temperature keeps rising, many regions will suffer extreme weather. When the ice caps melt, the sea levels rise, and coastal cities face floods. If forests are destroyed, animals lose their homes and people lose valuable resources.

At the same time, human choices can make a difference. If we reduce pollution, the air becomes cleaner and healthier. When people recycle more, the amount of waste in landfills decreases. If countries work together, they will find new solutions for energy and transportation.

However, problems continue when actions are ignored. If factories keep producing without limits, the situation will get worse. When people waste energy at home, they make the problem bigger. If nothing changes, the damage might be impossible to repair.
