Present perfect Has, have + P.P	- To talk about indefinite time in the past -events that began in the past and continue into present	- they have lived her for five years - she has played football since she was five years old	-they haven't lived her for five years - she hasn't played football since she was five years old	- have they lived her? - Has she played football?	Since – for – just
Present progressive Is, am, are + v (ing)	-For actions occurring now - for temporary situation	- Ali lives in Riyadh, but he is studying in France this year	-he isn't studying in France -they aren't going to school now	- is he studying in France? - Are they going to school now?	Now – this – at the moment – during – today – still
