Jalur Gemilang is a combination of symbols and representation of all the states under the federation. The 14 stripes and 14 points of the star represent the 14 states in Malaysia.

Jalur is a Malay word meaning stripe of colours. There are 14 red and white stripes that symbolise a common mission, direction and virtuous path followed by Malaysians. *Gemilang* means bright, brilliant or excellent.

The red colour means strength and bravery in facing challenges. The white colour symbolises honesty and integrity. The dark blue colour represents the unity and harmony of the people in Malaysia.

The crescent moon represents Islam as the federal religion of Malaysia. The 14-pointed star symbolises the unity of all states and the federal territories in Malaysia. The yellow colour of the crescent moon and star is the royal colour of the Rulers.
