| D. cyber-bullying | 4. Stealing goods from a store without paying. |
| E. phishing | 5. Using another person's personal details (like their name, bank info, or password) to steal money or commit crimes. |
| F. shoplifting | 6. Sending fake emails or messages to make people reveal personal information (like passwords or bank details). |
| G. fraud | 7. Taking someone else's property without permission. |
| H. vandalism | 8. Lying to get money or benefits in an illegal way (for example, faking documents or insurance claims). |
