

When doing subtraction, remember to:

- 1 - write the larger numeral above and the smaller numeral below
- 2 - subtract the digits in the ones column first, then the digits in the tens column

- 1) Geron had 45 ducks in a duck pen. 32 got away, how many ducks remained in the pen?

$$45 - 32$$

Answer = ducks

- 2) Ali had 18 biscuits. He ate 7. How many biscuits does he have left?

$$18 - 7$$

Tens Ones

Answer = biscuits

3) Kate has 16 lollipops. She gave Carl 6 lollipops. How many lollipops has she now?

$$16 - 6$$

Tens Ones

Answer = lollipops

4) There are 77 chairs and 7 tables in a room. How many more chairs are there than tables?

$$77 - 7$$

Tens Ones

Answer = chairs

5) There were 48 boys on the playground. If 6 boys went home, how many boys were still on the playground?

$$48 - 6$$

Answer = boys
