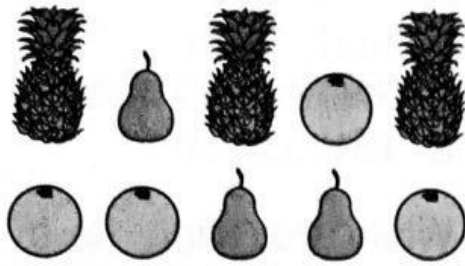

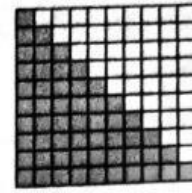
A $\frac{2}{7} + \frac{3}{7} = \frac{5}{14}$
