Discussion Text

1. Definition

A Discussion Text is a type of text that presents different opinions or arguments about a particular issue. It discusses both sides: the pros (advantages) and the cons (disadvantages), before drawing a conclusion or recommendation.

2. Purpose

The purposes of a discussion text are:

- To present information and opinions about an issue.
- To give readers/listeners balanced views before making a decision.
- To encourage critical thinking and reasoning.

3. Generic Structure

- Issue → introduction of the topic or problem being discussed.

Example: "In modern life, students are encouraged to use gadgets for learning. However, there are arguments for and against this idea."

- Arguments For (Pros) → reasons or points that support the issue.

Example: "Using gadgets helps students access more information quickly."

- Arguments Against (Cons) → reasons or points that oppose the issue.

Example: "However, gadgets may cause distractions and addiction."

- Conclusion / Recommendation → writer's final opinion or suggestion.

Example: "Therefore, gadgets should be used wisely to gain the benefits while reducing the risks."

4. Language Features

- Simple Present Tense (karena membahas fakta/pendapat umum).
"Nature gives people many benefits."

- Connectives / Conjunctions to connect arguments:

On the other hand, in addition, however, therefore, besides, moreover, while, although.

- Modal verbs for giving opinions:

should, must, may, might, can, could.

- Causal language (menyatakan sebab-akibat):

because, as a result, therefore, due to.

- Objective tone → menggunakan bahasa formal dan netral.

5. Example of Discussion Text

Topic: Should Students Wear School Uniforms?

Issue: Many schools require students to wear uniforms. Some people believe uniforms are beneficial, while others argue against them.

Arguments For: Uniforms create a sense of equality among students and reduce bullying related to clothing. They also help students focus on learning instead of fashion.

Arguments Against: However, uniforms limit students' freedom of expression. Some parents also complain about the cost of buying specific uniforms.

Conclusion: Wearing uniforms has both advantages and disadvantages. Schools should balance the policy by allowing students to wear casual clothes on certain days while keeping uniforms for formal events.

6. Key Vocabulary in Discussion Text

Advantages / Pros: benefits, strengths, positive aspects, opportunities.

Disadvantages / Cons: drawbacks, weaknesses, negative aspects, risks.

Neutral Words: issue, argument, point of view, balance, consider.

Connectors: on the other hand, in contrast, however, besides, moreover.
