

to: reaction to, happen to, listen to, make a contribution to

about: talk about, complain about smth/smb

for: for a long time, wait for, for+period of time (for a few years), for the first time, prepare for smth (but prepare **to V1**)

at: laugh at, shout at

from: graduate from

No preposition: influence smb/ smth, date smb, answer the questions, discuss smth, go home, face smth etc.
