A **prefix** can be added¹ to the beginning of a word.

It changes the meaning of the word.

The prefix pre- means before.

Premade means made before (= заранее приготовленный).

The prefix re- means again.

Redo means do again (= переделывать)

The prefix mis- means incorrectly or poorly (= неправильно, плохо).

Misread means read incorrectly (= неправильно читать)
