

Use the prefixes pre-, re- and mis-

A **prefix** can be added¹ to the beginning of a word.

It changes the meaning of the word.

The prefix **pre-** means *before*.

Premade means *made before* (= заранее приготовленный).

The prefix **re-** means *again*.

Redo means *do again* (= переделывать)

The prefix **mis-** means *incorrectly or poorly* (= неправильно, плохо).

Misread means *read incorrectly* (= неправильно читать)
