In your talk you should:

- **formulate the issue raised in the material,**
- **compare the information provided in the material,**
- **state your opinion on the issue,**
- **support your opinion with at least two arguments, including reasons and examples,**
- **come to a conclusion.**

Source 1:

Choosing between textbooks and online learning for secondary school students can be a tough decision to make. There are several advantages and disadvantages to each method. The main reason is that print books offer readers a better experience encouraging active critical thinking and interaction with the material. For example, students can make notes, and do the exercises in the material writing by hand.

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Source 2:

Teachers reported that students have a better chance of remembering the information when they use books. In addition, researchers found that reading on a screen requires more concentration and is less effective than reading on paper. As a result, some students need help focusing on homework when using a computer. Still, a lot of young learners love it when there's a chance to study online during a lesson.
