of: accuse of, afraid of

for: for+period of time (e.g. for a few days), prepare for smth (but prepare **to V1**), ask for, thank sb for, wait for

at: at the age of, at the same time, at + 'event' (at the party)

in: in the morning, in the afternoon, in the evening, participate in

No preposition: enter smth, ... years older, influence sb, answer the questions, call sb, leave home etc.
