Its capital is Washington, D.C.. Famous landmarks include the Statue of Liberty, Mount Rushmore, and the long Mississippi River. The islands of Hawaii are also very popular.

In Canada, both English and French are official languages. Canada is known for its friendly people, poutine as a traditional dish, and celebrations such as **Canada Day**. The capital is **Ottawa**, and landmarks include the CN Tower, the **Rocky Mountains**, the St. Lawrence River, and Vancouver Island.

Together, these three countries show the cultural richness of North America through their food, traditions, religion, language, and landmarks.
