Most teenage boys become novice monks for a while, about a year, to earn merit for their families. Many exuberant festivals are connected to both Buddhism and the changing seasons (such as Loy Krathong — Thailand's Festival of Lights). The whole country is much influenced by Western thought and lifestyle. Thai people are easily satisfied and they believe that life should be fun.
