###### ♀ BUỚC 1: GẠCH CHÂN TỪ KHÓA (Underline keywords)

**Mục tiêu:** Nhìn rõ câu đang nói về nội dung gì.

**Ví dụ:** As a child, he had an interest in drawing, photography and cinema.

Câu đang nói về **sở thích/đam mê ban đầu** của Andy Warhol khi còn nhỏ: ông ấy có sự quan tâm đến nghệ thuật, gồm **vẽ, nhiếp ảnh, điện ảnh**.

###### ● BUỚC 2: ĐỌC LUỐT & QUÉT THÔNG TIN (Skim & Scan)

**Skimming** = Đọc nhanh để hiểu ý chính của cả đoạn

**Scanning** = Nhìn kỹ những đoạn gần chỗ trống để tìm manh mối

**Ví dụ:** Đọc đoạn thông tin ở đầu, ta có thể thấy:

- **Skim:** Thông tin cho thấy Andy Warhol **hình thành đam mê nghệ thuật từ bé**.

- **Scan các đáp án:**

- **created** → “tạo ra” → sai, vì ông ấy không tạo ra “interest”.
- **grew** → “mọc/lớn lên” → sai về collocation (*grow an interest* không tự nhiên).
- **increased** → “tăng lên” → không hợp ngữ cảnh (không nói niềm quan tâm tăng, mà nói là hình thành).
- **developed** → “hình thành/phát triển” → đúng collocation: *develop an interest*.

(+)	<b>S + am/is/are + V (P.P) + (by O).</b> <i>E.g. The heavy boxes <b>are carried</b> by James.</i>
(-)	<b>S + am/is/are + not + V (P.P) + (by O).</b> <i>E.g. Global warming <b>isn't properly addressed</b> in the documentary.</i>
(?)	<b>Am/Is/Are + S + V (P.P) + (by O)?</b> <i>E.g. <b>Is the dog walked</b> by Mr. James?</i> <b>Wh-word + am/is/are + S + V (P.P) + (by O)?</b> <i>E.g. <b>Where is the party held</b> by your friend?</i>

##### II. Past simple passive (Câu bị động thì quá khứ đơn)

(+)	<b>S + was/were + V (P.P) + (by O).</b> <i>E.g. The mistakes <b>were corrected</b> by the teacher.</i>
(-)	<b>S + was/were + not + V (P.P) + (by O).</b> <i>E.g. The wallet <b>was not given</b> by him.</i>
(?)	<b>Was/Were + S + V (P.P) + (by O)?</b> <i>E.g. <b>Were all the candies sold</b> by the little boy?</i> <b>Wh-word + was/were + S + V (P.P) + (by O)?</b> <i>E.g. <b>When was the church built?</b></i>

##### III. Present perfect passive (Câu bị động thì hiện tại hoàn thành)

(+)	<b>S + have/has + been + V (P.P) + (by O).</b> <i>E.g. The letters <b>have been sent</b> by Tom.</i>
(-)	<b>S + have/has + not + been + V (P.P) + (by O).</b> <i>E.g. The project <b>has not been completed</b> by the team.</i>
(?)	<b>Have/Has + S + been + V (P.P) + (by O)?</b> <i>E.g. <b>Has the package been delivered</b> by the courier?</i> <b>Wh-word + have/has + S + been + V (P.P) + (by O)?</b> <i>E.g. <b>Where have the keys been found</b> by the staff?</i>

\*Note: S = chủ ngữ; V (P.P) = past participle: quá khứ phân từ; by O = by + đối tượng thực hiện hành động.

##### - Vị trí của trạng từ chỉ thời gian trong câu bị động

- Trạng từ chỉ thời gian (yesterday, last week, in 1999, already, yet, since, for...) thường đặt **ở cuối câu**.
- Nếu muốn nhấn mạnh thông tin về thời gian, có thể đặt ở đâu câu.
- Một số trạng từ đặc biệt (already, just, never, ever, yet) thì **đặt sau have/has** trong thì **Present Perfect Passive**.
- Nếu câu bị động có cụm “by + agent”, thì trạng từ chỉ thời gian có thể đứng trước “by”.

**E.g.** The documents were signed last night by the director.

This novel was published in 1997 by a small local company.
