PROCEDURE

Definition

Procedure text is a type of text that provides a sequence of steps or instructions on how to create, do, or use something.

Purpose

The main purpose of a procedure text is to explain how to accomplish a task, with common examples including recipes for cooking, manuals for operating devices, or rules for games.



Structure

Goal

Which states the purpose or objective

Materials

List all the items, tools, or ingredients required to perform the procedure.

Content: This section details what you will need to complete the task successfully.

Example: For a cooking procedure, this would be a list of food items like "2 eggs, milk, butter".

Materials terbagi menjadi:

- **Ingredients** : Bahan-bahan yang dipakai
- **Tools** : Alat-alat yang dibutuhkan

Steps

To outline the actions or instructions in a clear, sequential order.



Language Features

Imperative Sentence (Kalimat Perintah)

Selalu menggunakan
Simple Present Tense dan
selalu diawali oleh *Verb 1*
dari *Action Verb*.

Example:

Bake the dough.

Adverbs of Time (Keterangan Waktu)

Example:

Fry each side **for two minutes**.

Adverbs of Manner (Keterangan Cara)

Example:

Pour the milk **slowly**.

Adverbs of Sequence (Keterangan Urutan)

Example:

- First,
- Second,
- Next,
- After that,
- Then,
- Finally,
- Lastly,



Imperative Sentence

An imperative sentence is a sentence that gives a command, makes a request, issues an instruction, or offers a piece of advice.

Example:

Please, pass me the pen.

Most of the time, an imperative sentence ends with a period, but it can also end with an exclamation point
