Intergenerational trauma refers to emotional pain that passes from parents to their children and grandchildren. This happens when parents who have experienced terrible events like war, abuse, or extreme poverty cannot fully recover from these experiences. Without realizing it, they pass their emotional wounds to the next generation. In today's world, families still suffer from past traumatic events that affected their ancestors.

Scientists have discovered that trauma can affect how our bodies work at a deep level. This means children may **inherit** not only their parents' appearance but also their emotional reactions to stress and fear. Parents who have lived through trauma often develop unhealthy habits such as avoiding emotions, being too protective, or finding it hard to show love. These behaviors then influence how they raise their children, creating a pattern that continues through many generations.

The effects of intergenerational trauma are common in modern communities. Children growing up in these families may feel anxious, depressed, and struggle to build healthy relationships, even though they never experienced the original traumatic event themselves. They may also have trust problems and feel deep sadness or fear without understanding why.

Teaching children to understand and express their feelings properly, and giving them safe, loving environments are important steps. These actions help stop the **continuation** of pain and create healthier family relationships for future generations.
