A. Recruitment vs. Conscription

Resulted from manpower shortage and some cotton growers prioritizing cotton over food.

B. Conscription Details

Volunteers initially filled the ranks, but conscription became necessary as the war prolonged.

C. Emancipation Proclamation

Both Union and Confederacy enforced conscription with exemptions and alternatives.

Issued by Lincoln in 1863 to free slaves, impacting the war's dynamics and morale.
