

TIP

A **consonant digraph** is made up of two consonants that together represent one sound. **Sh** and **th** are consonant digraphs. Listen for the **sh** sound at the beginning of short and at the end of rush. You can hear the **th** sounds in thumb, that, and fourth.

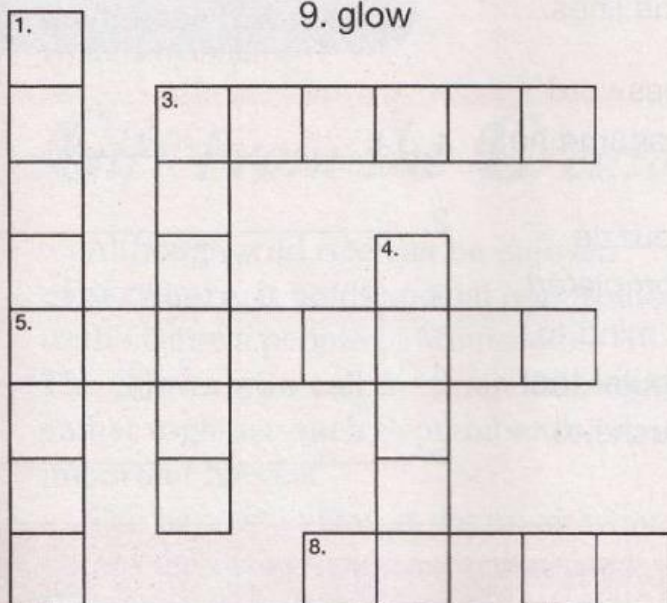

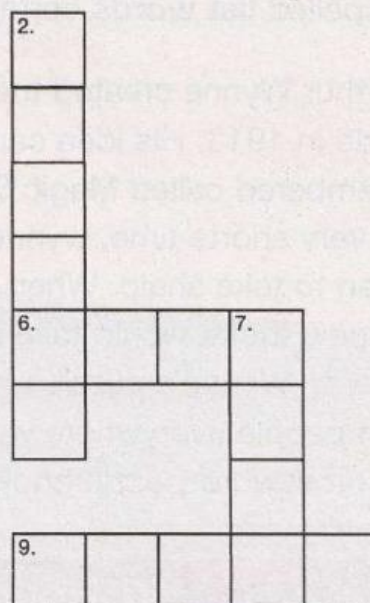

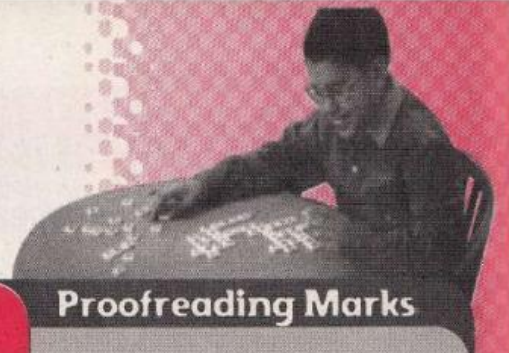
