UNIDADES DE LONGITUD

Ejemplo:

$$250 \text{ km} \rightarrow \text{m}; \quad 250 \text{ km} \cdot \frac{1000 \text{ m}}{1 \text{ km}} = \frac{250 \cdot 1000}{1} = 250000 \text{ m}$$

1) $40 \text{ m} \rightarrow \text{mm}$
