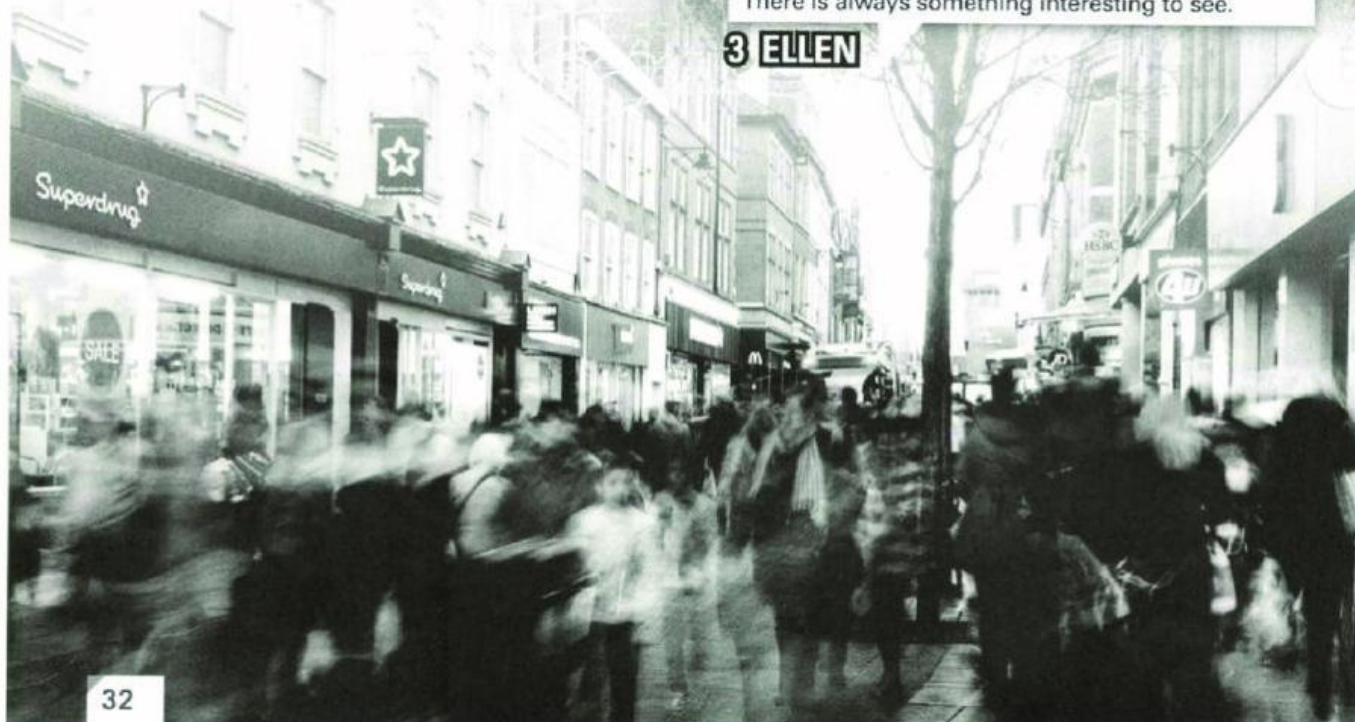
#### 1 DARIA
