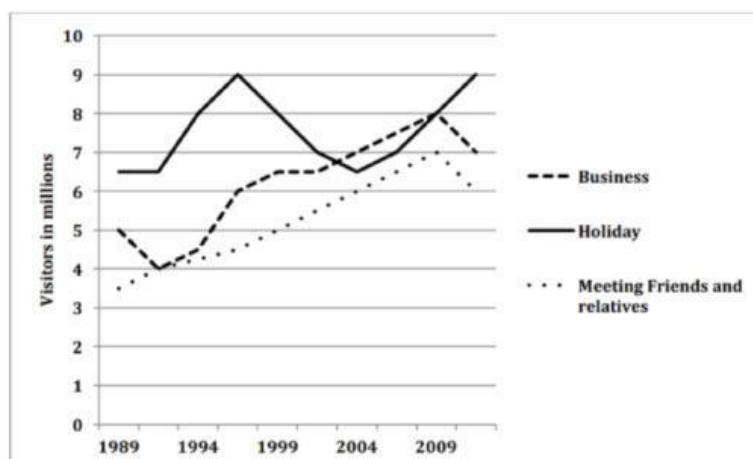


Task 1

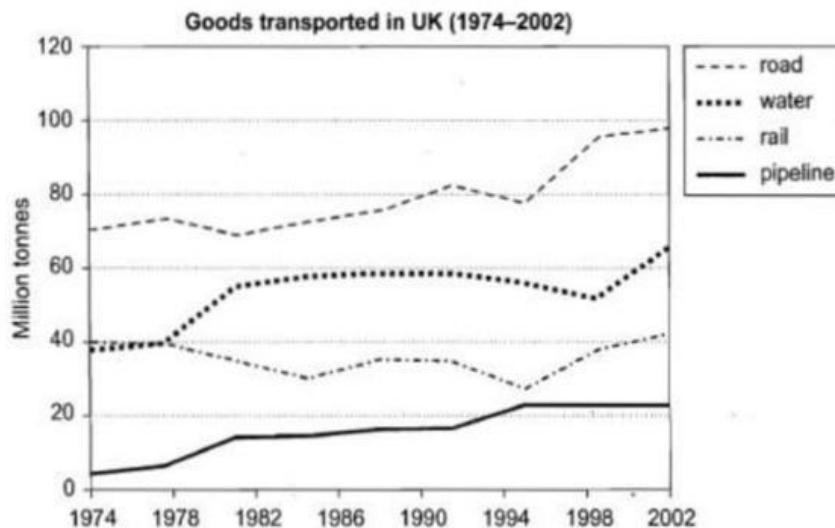
