X : Why don't you do it at home?

Y : I have a part-time job in the evening, so when I get home, I'll be too tired to do an assignment.

X : What do you work as?

### LANGUAGE NOTES

"Where are you off to?"

: Where are you going?

Example:

X : Hey, Jim! Where are you off to?

Y : To my mail box.
