"First of all"

: before doing anything else; before anything else.

Example:

- First of all, let me ask you something.
- First of all, I want you to understand that I did it for us.

X : *Why don't you* do it at home?

Y : I have a part-time job in the evening, so when I get home, I'll be too tired to do an assignment.

X : *What do you work as?*

Y : I work at a cafe. I work as a _____. I take orders from the guests. I also serve food and beverages to them.



LANGUAGE NOTES

"Where are you off to"

: Where are you going?

Example:

X: Hey, Jim! Where are you off to?

Y: To my mail box.
