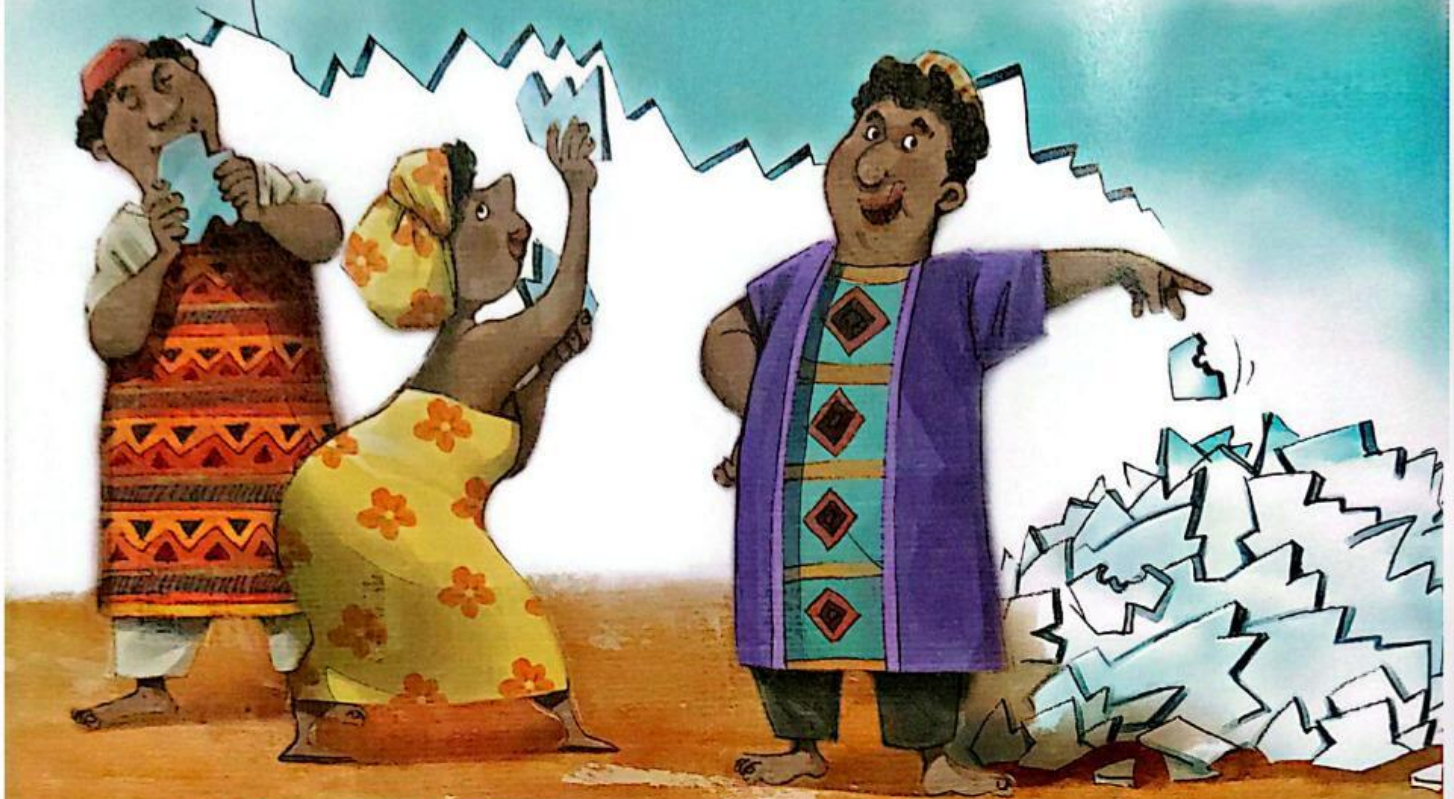


Why the Sky Is Far Away

Why did the sky move far away from the people?

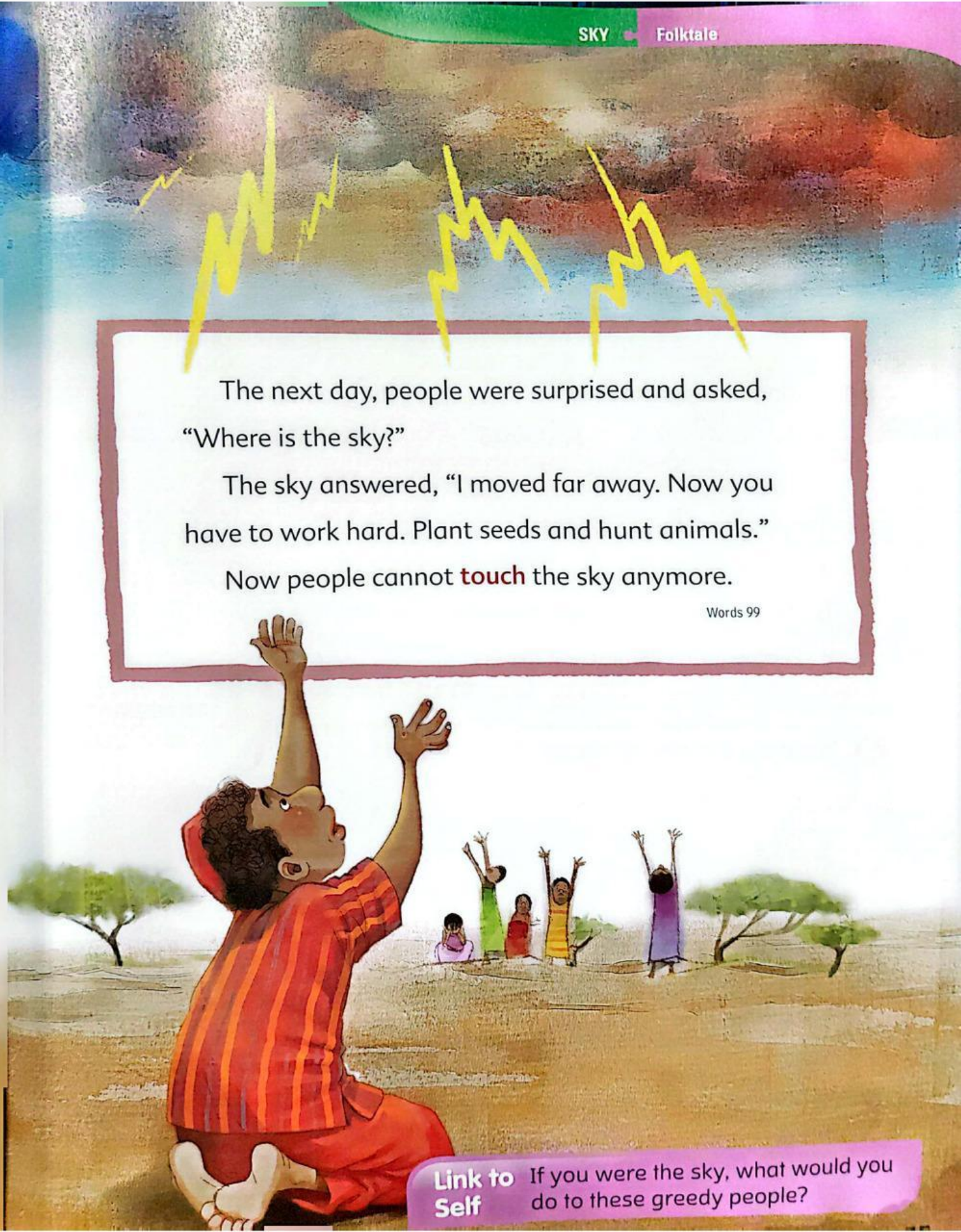
Long ago, the sky was close to the ground.
