#### CLAUSES OF RESULT WITH **SUCH/SO ... THAT**

**Such + a + adjective + noun ... that**

e.g. It was such a hot day that we decided to go swimming.

**So + adjective ... that**

e.g. The wind was so strong that ...

**So + adverb ... that**

e.g. It rained so hard that there were lots of flooded areas.

**So much/many/few/little + noun + that**

e.g. There was so much dust that we couldn't see what was happening.
