GEOGRAPHY Las Vegas is situated in a basin on the floor of the Mojave Desert and is surrounded by mountain ranges on all sides. The landscape is rocky and arid, the desert vegetation.

CLIMATE Subtropical hot desert climate with long, extremely hot summers; warm transitional seasons; and short winters with mild days & cool nights.

WILDLIFE Mountain lions, bobcats, sheep, coyotes, roadrunners, owls, tortoises and reptiles are among the hundreds of species that share the desert with Las Vegas.
