When a short-vowel word ends with one consonant, double the consonant before adding an ending that begins with a vowel.

swim + er = swimmer

cut + ing = cutting

Do not double the final x in base words ending in x.

flex + ing = flexing

fax + ed = faxed

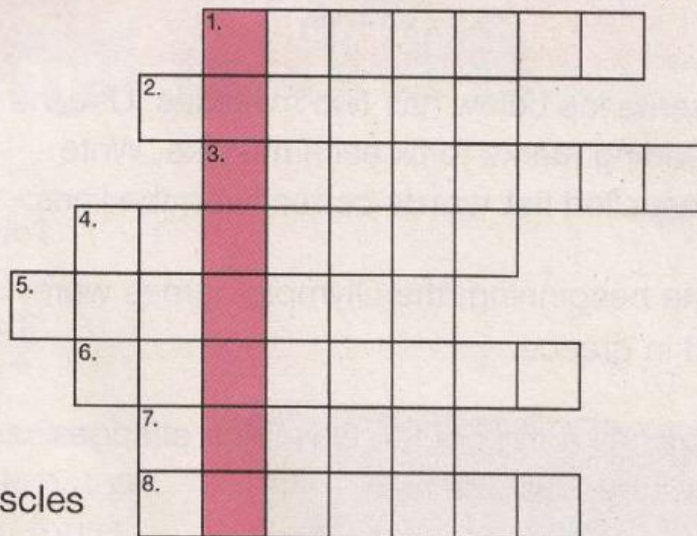
