

PRESENT SIMPLE & PRESENT CONTINUOUS

Present Simple

I play He plays
I don't play He doesn't play
Do I play? Does he play?

I eat pizza every Friday.
She eats pizza every day.

Present Continuous

I'm playing He's playing
I'm not playing He is not playing
Am I playing? Am I playing?

I am eating pizza now.
She is eating pizza at the moment.
