

## 12B GRAMMAR past simple revision

Put the verbs in the past simple.

A I <sup>1</sup> didn't like that restaurant. (not like)

B Yes, the food <sup>2</sup> was really bad. (be)

A My cousin <sup>3</sup> \_\_\_\_\_ with us last weekend. (stay)

B That's nice! What <sup>4</sup> \_\_\_\_\_ you \_\_\_\_\_? (do)

A We <sup>5</sup> \_\_\_\_\_ to a museum and we <sup>6</sup> \_\_\_\_\_ lunch in the city centre. (go / have)

A Do you have Alan's phone number?

B Yes, I <sup>7</sup> \_\_\_\_\_ it on a piece of paper. Here it is! (write)

A <sup>8</sup> \_\_\_\_\_ you \_\_\_\_\_ the football match yesterday? (watch)

B Yes, I did. It was great!

A I <sup>9</sup> \_\_\_\_\_ a really interesting film last night. (see)

B <sup>10</sup> \_\_\_\_\_ it the film with Scarlett Johansson? It was great! (be)

A I <sup>11</sup> \_\_\_\_\_ in Russia when I was little. (live)

B Really? <sup>12</sup> \_\_\_\_\_ you \_\_\_\_\_ to speak Russian? (learn)

A No, I didn't!

A There you are!

B Sorry! We <sup>13</sup> \_\_\_\_\_ the house really late! (leave)

A Where <sup>14</sup> \_\_\_\_\_ you \_\_\_\_\_ last summer? (go)

B We <sup>15</sup> \_\_\_\_\_ a lovely house in Spain. And you? (rent)

A How did you get to the airport?

B We <sup>16</sup> \_\_\_\_\_ time, so we <sup>17</sup> \_\_\_\_\_ a bus. (have / get)

A <sup>18</sup> \_\_\_\_\_ you at home yesterday? I <sup>19</sup> \_\_\_\_\_ you, but you <sup>20</sup> \_\_\_\_\_. (be / phone / not answer)

B No, I <sup>21</sup> \_\_\_\_\_. I <sup>22</sup> \_\_\_\_\_ my phone with me! Sorry! (be / not have)

A Where's Martin?

B Oh, he <sup>23</sup> \_\_\_\_\_ me a text message. He can't come. (send)

A What did you do last night?

B We <sup>24</sup> \_\_\_\_\_ to go to the cinema, but there <sup>25</sup> \_\_\_\_\_ any good films, so we <sup>26</sup> \_\_\_\_\_ at home. (want / not be / stay)

A Is that a new phone?

B Yes! I <sup>27</sup> \_\_\_\_\_ it last week. (buy)

A I <sup>28</sup> \_\_\_\_\_ you at the concert yesterday. (not see)

B I <sup>29</sup> \_\_\_\_\_. I <sup>30</sup> \_\_\_\_\_ in hospital! (not go / be)

**20–28 Really good!** You can use the past simple very well.
