A Year of Global Festivals

People around the world enjoy special celebrations in every season. These festivals often have unique **traditions** that bring people together.

In the **winter**, people in India will celebrate **Diwali**, the Festival of Lights. Families will clean their homes, light small oil lamps called *diyas*, and decorate the floors with colorful designs called *rangoli*. They will wear new clothes and share **mithai** (sweets) with friends and family. The celebration symbolizes the triumph of good over evil.



In the **spring**, people in India will also celebrate **Holi**, the Festival of Colors. People gather in public spaces and throw **colored powders** and colored water at each other in a joyous celebration of the arrival of spring and the victory of good over evil. They will also eat special festive foods.

In the **summer**, people in France will celebrate **Bastille Day** on July 14th. The day starts with a large **military parade** on the Champs-Élysées in Paris. In the evening, people will enjoy picnics, public dances called *bals des pompiers* (firemen's balls), and huge **fireworks** displays, especially around the Eiffel Tower.



In the **fall**, people in the United States and Canada will celebrate **Thanksgiving**. Families will gather together to share a large, special meal. The traditional meal includes foods like roast turkey, cranberry sauce, and pumpkin pie. Many people also watch the famous Thanksgiving Day **parades** on television. This holiday is a time to express **gratitude** for the blessings of the past year.
