COMPARISONS IN TOURISM

Read the following conversation at the travel agency.

(T = Travel Agent, C = Customer)

C: ...I've heard London has more interesting museums than Paris.

T: London is more expensive than Paris, but the flight to London is longer than the flight to Paris.

Would you consider other options, maybe taking a train or renting a car?

C: Sure. I imagine trains are slower than planes.

T: It depends on the place. Most train stations are closer to downtown than local airports.

If the adjective (describing word) is one syllable, you can add **-r/-er/-ier+ than**

For example:

small - smaller; slow - slower;
nice - nicer; easy - easier.

With other English adjectives of two syllables and more, you can't change their endings. Instead, you should use **more + adjective + than**

For example:

interesting - more interesting;
beautiful - more beautiful;
expensive - more expensive.

With a partner, use the following information to create a conversation.

Philadelphia to Boston. June 8th.

	train	plane	bus
Price	from 32 usd	from 44 usd	from 40 usd
Time	8 hours	1.15 hours	7 hours
Distance (from downtown)	0.37 miles	4.8 miles	0.5 miles



You can also use:

The main square is (much) more interesting than here.

The dock is (a bit) – closer to the main square than the train station.
