Word	Use	Example (Profile)
just	very recent action	I've <u>just</u> arrived at my eco-lodge. (<i>Eco-Traveler</i>)
already	something done earlier than expected	She's <u>already</u> booked her next museum tour. (<i>Cultural</i>)
yet	something expected, not done (in negatives/questions)	Have you tried the local food <u>yet</u> ? (<i>Foodie</i>)
ever	at any time in your life (questions)	Have you <u>ever</u> worked while traveling? (<i>Digital Nomad</i>)
never	at no time in your life	I've <u>never</u> traveled alone. (<i>Family / Retired</i>)


