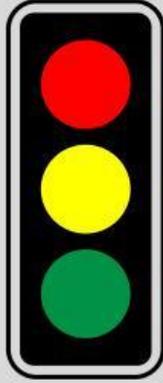
1. What grammar or expression did you use most confidently this unit?
