Role Play

Be a Waiter and Customer

Instruction:

- Arrange the classroom like a small restaurant:
- Half of the class becomes waiters/waitresses (stand behind desks as "restaurant tables").
- Half of the class becomes customers (move from table to table).

Step 1 - Warm-Up

The teacher quickly reviews polite expressions:

- "I'd like to have..."
- "Can you make it less spicy?"
- "Would you like something to drink?"

Step 2

- Students are divided into two groups: waiters and customers.
- Waiters stand behind tables with menus.
- Customers carry a "Customer Card" to record their orders.

Restaurant	Food Ordered	Drink Ordered	Preference
1	Fried rice	Iced tea	Less spicy
2	Chicken sandwich	Juice	No ice
3	Spaghetti	Water	Less oily

Step 3 - Movement Activity:

- Each customer visits 3 different tables (restaurants).
- At each table, they:
 - Greet the waiter
 - Order food and drink
 - Add one preference (e.g., less salty, no ice, extra cheese)
- The waiter writes down the customer's order on a small "Order Note."

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Step 4 - Rotation:

- After 2 minutes, the teacher says "Change!"
- Customers move to the next table.
- Waiters stay in place.

Step 5 - Role Switch:

- After three rounds, switch roles – customers become waiters and vice versa.
