A. GRAMMAR

❖ Present passive (Thể bị động ở thì Hiện tại đơn)

Cấu trúc	Active (chủ động):	S	+	V(s,es)	+	O
	Passive (bị động):	S	+	am/is/are + PII	+	(by O)

Ví dụ	Active (chủ động):	My father	paints	the walls.
	Passive (bị động):	The walls	are painted	by my father.

Note: PII = Past participle: quá khứ phân từ, O = Object: tân ngữ, S = Subject: chủ ngữ, V = Verb: động từ.

Lưu ý: Nếu S trong câu chủ động là: they, people, everyone, someone, anyone, etc → được bỏ đi trong câu bị động.

Ví dụ: Active: **People speak English** all over the world.

→ Passive: **English is spoken** all over the world.

• Past participle of regular verbs (Quá khứ phân từ của các động từ có quy tắc)

CÔNG THỨC: Động từ + -ed = Đã làm gì

No.	V-inf	PII	Meaning	No.	V-inf	PII	Meaning
1	clean	cleaned	đã lau dọn	4	travel	traveled/travelled	đã đi (du lịch)
2	cook	cooked	đã nấu	5	use	used	đã dùng
3	paint	painted	đã tô/đã sơn	6	bake	baked	đã nướng

Lưu ý: - Động từ kết thúc bằng "e": Chỉ thêm "-d". Ví dụ: *bake* → *baked*

- Động từ kết thúc bằng phụ âm + y đổi y thành i + ed. Ví dụ: *study* → *studied*

- Động từ một âm tiết kết thúc bằng phụ âm + nguyên âm + phụ âm: Gấp đôi phụ âm cuối rồi thêm "-ed".

Ví dụ: *stop* → *stopped*

• Past participle of irregular verbs (Quá khứ phân từ của các động từ bất quy tắc)

before (trước khi)	Chỉ thứ tự: Hành động trong mệnh đề before xảy ra trước hành động chính .	Before I go to bed, I brush my teeth.
when (khi, khi nào)	Chỉ thời điểm: Mô tả khoảnh khắc hành động xảy ra.	When I wake up, I like to drink a glass of water.
then (sau đó, tiếp đó)	Chỉ thứ tự liên mạch: Hành động xảy ra ngay sau .	Then , I watch TV.
after that (sau đó)	Chỉ thứ tự ngắt nghỉ: Hành động xảy ra sau .	After that , I go for a walk in the park.
