**in** → months, years, seasons, parts of the day (in the morning, in June, in winter, in 2025)

**on** → days, dates, special days (on Monday, on my birthday, on the weekend)

**at** → exact times, holiday periods, night (at 7 o'clock, at Christmas, at night)
