Subject Pronouns	I	You	He	She	It	We	They
Object Pronouns	me	you	him	her	it	us	them

We use subject pronouns when the pronoun is a subject.
(before a verb)

Ex: She goes home.
They tell a story.

We say goodbye.
He speaks slowly.

We use object pronouns when the pronoun is an object of a verb. (after a verb)

Ex: -I met him.
-She gave me a book.

We see her.
I want to tell you.
