Objective: To improve pronunciation accuracy, listening comprehension, and sentence writing skills.

PART 1 – PRONUNCIATION PRACTICE

Instruction:

 Click the microphone icon  and **read each sentence aloud**.

If your pronunciation is correct, the bar will turn **green**.

If it's incorrect, it will turn **red** — try again until it turns green!

(In Liveworksheet, use the feature: speech recognition → check pronunciation accuracy)

Sentences to Read:

- 1 I always try to speak English confidently.
- 2 Reading every day helps me learn faster.
- 3 My favorite subject is English literature.
- 4 Learning new words makes me feel smarter.
- 5 I like discussing ideas with my classmates.
- 6 Practicing speaking every day improves my fluency.
- 7 A good speaker always listens carefully first.
- 8 Don't be afraid to make mistakes when you speak English.

 **Tip:** Encourage students to repeat until pronunciation accuracy $\geq 90\%$.

PART 2 – LISTEN & TYPE (DICTATION & WRITING PRACTICE)

Instruction:

 Click the audio button  to **listen carefully** to each sentence.

Then, **type the exact sentence** you hear in the box.

If your answer is wrong, it will appear **in red** until you correct it.

(In Liveworksheet, use the "listening input" or "dictation" function with audio: tag)

Example Format (Liveworksheet Code Style):

 audio: sentence1.mp3

→ writeanswer: I love learning new English expressions.

 audio: sentence2.mp3

→ writeanswer: My teacher helps me improve my pronunciation.

 audio: sentence3.mp3

→ writeanswer: Speaking practice builds my confidence.

 audio: sentence4.mp3

→ writeanswer: I enjoy talking about interesting topics.

 audio: sentence5.mp3

→ writeanswer: Every mistake is a step toward improvement.

 PART 3 – REFLECTION TASK

Instruction:

Type short answers to the questions below (minimum 1 sentence each):

- 1** What new words did you learn today?
- 2** How did you feel while practicing pronunciation?
- 3** What will you do to improve your speaking skills next time?

 This helps students reflect on progress and self-assess confidence.
